WHAT IS ICEFISH?

The Icelandic Fisheries Exhibition, dubbed IceFish, was first held in 1984 and covers every aspect of the commercial fishing industry. From locating, catching, processing and packaging, right through to the marketing and distribution of the end product, IceFish is a must for all commercial fisheries organisations.

In response to the request of the exhibitors, the event is held on a three-year cycle. This ensures that each IceFish is different from the last, showcasing fresh technologies, products and services, and providing its visitors with the latest developments from across the market.

The 2014 exhibition was a sell-out and saw attendance increase by 12% to 15,219 compared to 2011. It included inward missions from the Far East, Americas and Africa.

WHY EXHIBIT?

The Icelandic fisheries sector has been one of the mainstays of the Icelandic economy for as long as anyone can remember, both as a source of food for the nation as well as representing a significant proportion of Iceland's export income. 10,500 people are directly employed by the fisheries industry and in 2015 the value of the catch amounted to 151 billion ISK which was an increase of 15% on the previous year!

Skippers and owners update and modernise their fleet frequently and the **Icelandic Fisheries Exhibition** provides exhibitors with the ideal opportunity to meet and discuss new business requirements.



ICEFISH LOCATION

With a fleet of 1,663 registered fishing vessels landing 1,319 million tonnes of fish, the Icelandic Fleet and processing facilities represent the state of the art in fisheries technology.

The Icelandic Fisheries Exhibition is held in Kópavogur, a town just a ten-minute drive from Iceland's capital Reykjavik, which is easily accessible by boat and air from most major European cities. IceFish offers exhibitor shuttle services from the major hotels and ample parking facilities.
